

**WISNER-PILGER PUBLIC SCHOOL
BOARD OF EDUCATION
TRAINING AND PLANNING SESSION
FEBRUARY 26TH AND 27TH 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. on 26 February, 2011 at the Country Inn & Suites by President Chad Dixon. Notice of the meeting was posted in three public places three days prior to the meeting and an agenda was kept current in the office of the superintendent. President Dixon noted that a copy of the open meeting law was posting in the meeting room.

The Board of Education discussed educational issues for the Wisner-Pilger School District, including the Patron surveys, facility surveys, educational bills in Legislature, projected enrollment, option enrollment, NeSa-R scores and facility needs.

Robert Wynn with A.D.T. Education Security addressed the Board of Education regarding ways to increase security and safety in all of the district's buildings.

The self-evaluation of the Board of Education was discussed.

President Dixon recessed the meeting at 5:30 p.m.
