ACT has added a September test date. The actual testing date will be September 13, but the registration deadline is August 12. **Testing materials will not be available until August 1st. If a student qualifies for free or reduced lunch, that student can use a waiver fee for the testing fee. Those waivers can be picked up after August 1st.
